

Country Dance * New York admission charges (October 2008)

Tuesday: Full Price Admission is: Members: \$10 Non-members: \$13

Saturday: Full Price Admission is: Members: \$10 Non-members: \$14

Half-price Admission: Arriving just before the break (during the last dance or waltz) or just after, until after the second dance of the second half of the evening when the cash box has been put away and the door volunteers are released (after which it is free).

Member rate:

- Students (with ID)
- Pinewoods Folk Music Club (with membership card)
- Country Dance and Song Society, living more than 50 miles away (with card)

Youth rates:

- Under age 10: Free
- Age 10 – 16: Half the parent's rate (\$5/\$6.50/\$7)
- Age 16 – 18: Member rate

Free:

- Volunteer Pass (on list);
- 1st Timer Pass;
- Gift certificate;
- Volunteer for that night (sound, coordinator, door, refreshment)

Guests / Observers: Someone who just wants to observe or is the guest of a dancer who has paid admission that night but is not dancing themselves may watch without paying admission on regular Tuesday or Saturday. For special events -- e.g. Fall Fling, Yuletide Cotillion, March Meltdown, and Playford Ball -- non-dancing guests/observers may be asked to pay half price or some other amount to be determined by the dance organizer or coordinator.

Occasional special situations:

- Spouse/partner of caller or musician is expected to pay if they dance, unless special arrangements have been made by the program chair.
- Large groups who made arrangements in advance.

Saturday: Everyone must wear a wrist band - paid admission, and all volunteers - except caller & musicians.
