ENGLISH COUNTRY DANCING HAS SOMETHING FOR EVERYONE!

If you've ever seen a Jane Austen film, you've seen ECD—a style of partner dancing done in groups (sets) of two or more couples. ECD was done in the 17th century, and new dances and tunes are being written today. Some of the dances are stately, while others are lively.

It's customary to change partners after each dance, so you'll meet lots of other dancers. Most dances are easy to learn because figures are repeated. The caller initially leads a 'walk through,' then prompts during the dancing.
